

## IARC and Public Health England – BelMed TRAINING Site Visit: Developing the breast cancer screening pathway in England

**Location**

London, Loughborough and Nottingham, England

**Date**

19 – 28 April 2017

**Aims & objectives**

The site visit to a recognized breast cancer screening center, namely Public Health England (PHE), aims to provide knowledge on implementation of breast cancer screening by introducing and shadowing the PHE screening practices to relevant staff of Belarus national cancer screening management.

**Topics**

➤ **I. Developing the breast screening pathway**

The PHE experience on: screening organization and evaluation, communication, benefits and harms, ethics and legislation in breast cancer screening, managing information systems, quality assurance for cancer screening programs.

➤ **II. Mammographic screening**

Physics of Mammography, personal performance in mammographic screening (current scheme and how this could apply in Belarus), training.
